
Daiginjo, Junmai Daiginjo 大吟釀, 純米大吟釀

Cody's Junmai Daiginjo, Junmai Daiginjo, 720ml £ 56.95

Milling: 45% ABV: 15% Region: Gifu (C)

An elegant and well balanced Cody's Junmai Daiginjo with tropical, full body aroma and Creamy texture showing off the first non-Japanese sake brewer at Watanabe Brewery Western pallets beautifully. flavour. pleasing

Katafune Tobin, Daiginjo, 720ml £ 80.95

Milling: 45% ABV: 17% Region: Niigata (C)

Multiple IWC Trophy winner. It's a full bodied, mellow and sweet sake with notes of flowers and red cherries. Exquisite texture with beautiful definition, balance and a dry finish.

Kuncho Daiginjo [Classic] 8 Year Koshu , 720ml £ 63.00

Milling: 35% ABV: 15% Region: Oita (C)

Delicate straw colour - typical for koshu sake. Smooth, soft and well balanced palate.

Ginjo, Junmai Ginjo 吟釀, 純米吟釀

Cody's Junmai Ginjo, Junmai Ginjo, 720ml £48.80

Milling: 55% ABV: 15% Region: Gifu (C, W)

Aromatic and soft flavours of Cody's Junmai Ginjo make the sake ideal for Western pallet. Develops excellent umami flavour when paired with Unadon, pork dishes and grilled fish.

Morikuni Fufufu, Ginjo, 720ml £ 55.60

Milling: 60% ABV: 17% Region: Shodoshima (C, W)

Light straw coloured sake is a result of muroka technique of not using active charcoal for filtration. This method allows natural flavours and higher concentration of umami to remain. Light , crisp, and clean with a gentle fragrance of highly polished rice and mature, umami flavours. [fu:fu:fu:] Japanese onomatopoeia for chuckle, laughter and girly giggle.

Honjozo, Junmai, Futsushu 本醸造, 純米, 普通酒

Hinomaru 8 Year Old, Junmai Kimoto, 720ml £ 49.95

Milling: 60% ABV: 15.5% Region: Akita (C)

Clean tasting with salted caramel and aged soy sauce aromatics. Very complex on the palate with a finish reminiscent of coffee, chocolate and smoke.

Kuncho, Nigori Nama Genshu, 720ml £ 36.95

Milling: 70% ABV: 20.5% Region: Oita (C, W)

A quiet unique sake which is both unfiltered, unpasteurised and undiluted. Subtle aromatics with hints of the rice sweetness and a pleasantly dry finish.

Kuncho Red Label, Honjozo 720ml £ 38.00

Milling: 65% ABV: 15% Region: Oita (C, W)

Soft, easy drinking sake with clean and subtle palate.

Kuncho Shiboritate, Nama Genshu Honjozo, 720ml £ 39.35

Milling: 60% ABV: 18% Region: Oita (C)

Unpasteurised and undiluted fresh press of the season. Creamy palate, sweet yet refreshing.

Other sake

Akashi Tai Shiraume, Ginjo Umeshu, 500ml £ 33.95

Milling: NA ABV: 14.5% Region: Hyogo (C,W)

Ginjo sake blended harmoniously with the fruity flavour of Ume plums. The fruit is left to marinade for six months, removed, then the sake is left to age for a further two years. The result is an intense yet balanced liqueur full of dried fruit, date and plum flavours.

Hideyoshi Suzuki Shuzou LaChamte, Sparkling, 280ml £ 18.95

Milling: 65% ABV: 8% Region: Akita (C)

Sparkling sake full of the flavour of rice while being reminiscent of strawberries and cream. Perfectly textured with zesty acidity. Equally suitable as an aperitif or with dessert.

Champagne and Sparkling Wines

Krug, Grande Cuvee alc vol. £206.70

Chardonnay/Pinot Meunier/Pinot Noir NV Champagne, France 12% vol

Rich, complex with a toasty quality to the nose. On the palate it's nutty with fresh lemon acidity and delicate fine bubbles. An outstanding Champagne for special occasions.

Peller Estate, Ice Cuvee Sparkling alc vol. £59.50

Chardonnay/Pinot Noir/Vidal Ice Wine NV Ontario, Canada 12% vol

Peller Estate is renowned for its ice wines which requires grapes to be picked at temperatures no higher than -8°C. Straw coloured with a nose of apricot, yeast and ripe apple. Tropical fruit and refreshing sweet grapefruit on the palate.

Penley Estate Mythology Echo Sparkling Pinot Noir £37.60

Pinot Noir NV Australia 13.5% vol

A modern twist on the Australian classic, sparkling red. An abundance of fruit fills the nose, raspberries, strawberries and ripe cherries. The spicy undertones of star anise, liquorice and cinnamon and an extra level of complexity.

Ridgeview, Bloomsbury Brut £52.00

Chardonnay/Pinot Meunier/Pinot Noir NV Sussex, England 12% vol

Traditional method sparkling wine. Light golden colour with persistent mousse. Citrus fruit aromas with hints of melon and honey. Chardonnay brings finesse along with a crisp freshness. The pinot adds depth and character leading to a beautifully balanced finish.

Stelle d'Italia, Prosecco Brut £37.40

Glera NV Alto Adige, Italy 11% vol

Crisp sparkling wine with a delicate lemony character. Aromatic, dry and refreshing finish. Pairs perfectly with sushi.

The nose is enormously redolent of Manuka honey and yellow pollen. The palate is soft and creamy with citrus and a wonderful textural minerality, waxy lanolin notes and honey. Lovely palate weight and Vouvray-like body supports further complexity and decadence.

Flowery bouquet of rose petals and tropical fruits. Wine is dry but supple, with intense fruit and body on the palate. Amazingly balanced, offering hints of sweetness and spice.

Riesling	2013	Alsace, France	13% vol
Best dry wine in show winner, Decanter wine awards 2016. Textbook riesling nose of ripe citrus, some green apple, petrol and lots of minerals. Terrific harmony in the mouth with minerality and sweetness being perfectly partnered by gorgeous fruit.

Domaine Berhelemot Puligny – Montrachet Les Levrons **£70.00**

Chardonnay **2017** **Burgundy, France** **13 % vol**

The deep stony soil gives the wine its intensity and elegance typical of the land around Puligny. Aromas are floral with hints of almond and hazelnut and the wine is fresh and rich in the mouth.

Domaine Daniel Seguinot Chablis **£43.00**

Chardonnay **2017** **Chablis, France** **13% vol**

The vineyards of Maligny benefit from south-west exposure which brings considerable richness to the wines. The domaine has vineyards across Chablis appellation. Fresh, flinty nose then vibrant, fleshy fruit; very much the Séguinot style with a core of excellent quality Chardonnay and tight, mineral backbone.

Domaine du Haut Banchereau, Muscadet Sèvre et Maine Sur Lie **£29.10**

Melon de Bourgogne **2015** **Loire, France** **12% vol**

Lemon and brioche on the nose lead to lemony acidity and almonds on the palate. Wonderful zesty citrus finish makes this a perfect seafood wine.

Domaine Des Vieux Pruniers, Sancerre **£46.80**

Sauvignon Blanc **2017** **Loire, France** **13% vol**

Lemon and leafy green aromas on the nose with a palate full of citrus fruit and minerals. Finishes with a crisp, dry lengthy finish.

Gruber Rösschitz Weinviertel Grüner Veltliner Organic **£30.55**

Gruner Veltliner **2017** **Weinviertel, Austria** **12.5% vol**

A spicy, lively style of Gruner Veltliner that wakes up all your (wine) senses. With subtle apple aromas over an attractive white pepper note.

Long Meadow Ranch Sauvignon Blanc **£50.00**

Sauvignon Blanc **2014** **California, USA** **13% vol**

Nose and palate offer enticing kiwi, pineapple, melon and white mulberry. Lingering soft finish with a slight apricot sweetness. The wine is classically dry, perfectly ripe, and refreshing.

Lumiere Koshu Hikari **£41.70**

Koshu **2015** **Yamanashi, Japan** **11% vol**

Green apple nose with lemon and herbal aromas. Light body but intense citrus flavours and complex mineral notes. Subtle long finish.

Kardos Dry Furmint **£29.60**

Furmint **2017** **Tokaj, Hungary** **13% vol**

Pale green in colour with an intense nose. Fresh, with notes of gooseberry, pear and lime, which follow through on the palate. Dry and beautifully crisp with an elegant minerality which keeps the wine in balance.

Kovacs Nimrod Egri Csillag **£27.10**

Olaszrizling 30% / Leanyka 30% / Pinot Gris 20% / Chardonnay 20%

2017 Eger, Hungary 12% vol.

A white blend of gentle aromas and flavours. There's lovely honeysuckle aromas mixed with lifted lime fruit. The palate is light and fresh with subtle melon, green apple flavours and gentle honey notes.

Signus Vinho Verde **£24.00**

Loureiro/Trajadura/Arinto

2016 Vinho Verde, Portugal 10.5% vol.

Super fresh with a slight spritz. Full of green apple and tropical fruits. A mineral backbone gives this wine another layer of complexity.

Urlar Organic Pinot Gris **£43.00**

Pinot Gris 2016 Wairarapa, New Zealand 13% vol.

Opulent dry wine with aromas of pear and honeysuckle. A creamy texture on the palate from the lees stirring provides the backbone to a long, lingering finish.

Valenciso Rioja Blanco **£45.20**

Viura 70% , Garnacha Blanca 30%

2017 Rioja, Spain 14% vol.

Complex aromas combining floral characters with preserved lemon and gently smoky notes. The palate is intense and broad with nuts, stone fruit, minerality and balancing citrus acidity on the finish. Will continue to develop in the bottle.

Yealands, Land Made Sauvignon Blanc **£33**

Sauvignon Blanc 2018 Marlborough, New Zealand 12.5% vol.

Notes of stone fruit and guava, with a hint of fresh herbs. The palate is brimming with fresh fruit that is balanced with a long, crisp, mineral finish.

Bright cherry and raspberry aromas balanced by sweet spice. The palate is structured with complex, ripe red fruit, clove and black pepper characters. Poised and well-balanced with fresh acidity and a touch of mocha on the long finish.

Malvasija/Pinot Gris/Chardonnay 2009 Istra, Croatia 12.5% vol

5,000 bottles produced per year. Giorgio Clai is the legendary natural winemaker of Croatia, whose white wines are called 'orange' wines due to their colour. Fermented on natural yeasts in open vats. Aromas of dried candied fruit, figs and marzipan. Tasting resembles a christmas cake with orange peel, dried figs, honey and caramelized nuts. Served lightly chilled.

Alicante Bouschet 2015 Alicante, Spain 14.5% vol

Alicante Bouschet is one of the few grapes that has red juice. Smooth and balanced with glorious notes of ripe red berries and aromatic herbs leading to an opulently silky palate.
